## **ON THE ISSUE OF ADMINISTRATIVE REGULATION OF PREVENTIVE ACTIVITIES IN THE HEALTH SECTOR OF UKRAINE**

The article examines the current state of administrative and legal regulation of preventive activities in the health sector in Ukraine.

The author defines the administrative and legal regulation of preventive activities in the health sector as a deliberate state influence through appropriate administrative remedies on relationships that arise from the need to achieve short-and long-term goals of preventive activities – namely, to prevent deterioration of public health and improve the current state of health, involve in healthy lifestyle, and ultimately – increase economic potential, further development and improvement of the demographic situation, in order to organize these relationships and

their health. It is emphasized that the administrative and legal regulation of preventive activities in healthcare is done by publishing relevant state administrative regulations, ensure their implementation and the control of their implementation.

The author concludes that today in Ukraine there has been adopted a large number of administrative acts, which in one way or another deal with matters of preventive activities in the health sector. At present, prevention of diseases in Ukraine as a whole is in a phase of development, and therefore the administrative and legal regulation in this sphere is not formed. This leads to the fact that a significant number of regulations in this area are programmatic.
