DEINSTITUTIONALISATION OF POWER AS A CRIMINOGENIC FACTOR

In modern criminological and sociological works, criminalization of society is associated with increasing levels of crime and the extension of its influence on society.

This article discusses the criminalization of society, destruction of the institutional foundations of the functioning of bodies of state power and administration. The mechanisms of influence of criminal and economic processes in the activity of law enforcement bodies and public authorities are analyzed. It is concluded that the most favourable con-

ditions for the misappropriation of the levers of economic and political power is the situation of imbalance of social institutions. Countering artificial deinstitutionalization of state power is the main focus in the prevention of crminalization of society.

Based on the above the author makes an overall conclusion that opposition to artificial deinstitutionalisation government is a priority towards stabilization of public relations and the main focus in preventing criminalization of society.
